**ORDER PURSUANT TO BANKRUPTCY RULE 1015(b) DIRECTING JOINT  
ADMINISTRATION**

Upon the Motion<sup>1</sup> of the Debtors seeking entry of an order pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 1015(b) directing joint administration of such Chapter 11 cases; and it appearing that the relief requested is in the best interests of the Debtors' estates, their creditors and other parties in interest; and it appearing that the relief requested is essential to the continued operation of the Debtors' businesses; and it appearing that this Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and it appearing that this proceeding is a core proceeding within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2)(A); and it appearing that venue is proper in this District pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and adequate notice having been given; and it appearing that no other notice need be given; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is hereby ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion is granted.
2. The Debtors' respective captioned and numbered cases are consolidated for procedural purposes only and shall be jointly administered in accordance with Bankruptcy Rule 1015(b).

3. The caption of the Debtors' jointly administered cases is to read as follows:

An Order has been entered in this case directing the procedural consolidation and joint administration of the UAL Corporation Chapter 11 case and the Chapter 11 cases of UAL Corporation, UAL Loyalty Services, Inc., Confetti, Inc., Mileage Plus Holdings, Inc., Mileage Plus Marketing, Inc., MyPoints.com, Inc., Cybergold, Inc., iTarget.com, inc., MyPoints Offline Services, Inc., UAL Company Services, Inc., UAL Benefits Management, Inc., United BizJet Holdings, Inc., BizJet Charter, Inc., BizJet Fractional, Inc., BizJet Services, Inc., United Air Lines, Inc., Kion Leasing, Inc., Premier Meeting and Travel Services, Inc., United Aviation Fuels Corporation, United Cogen, Inc., Mileage Plus, Inc., United GHS, Inc., United Worldwide Corporation, United Vacations, Inc., Four Star Leasing, Inc., Air Wis Services, Inc., Air Wisconsin, Inc., Domicile Management Services, Inc..

5. A creditor filing a proof of claim against any of the Debtors shall file such proof of claim in the particular Debtor's bankruptcy case and not in the jointly administered case.

6. This Order is effective immediately upon its entry, and the clerk of the Court is hereby directed to enter this Order on the docket in each Debtor's Chapter 11 case.

7. This Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.

8. Notwithstanding the possible applicability of Bankruptcy Rules 6004(g), 7062, 9014, or otherwise, the terms and conditions of this Order shall be immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.

9. All time periods set forth in this Order shall be calculated in accordance with Rule 9006(a) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure.
